AGCAN FUNDING

Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada (AAFC) has developed the Indigenous Agriculture and Food Systems Initiative

to support Indigenous communities & entrepreneurs. IAFSI is a five-year, \$8.5M investment that will build capacity necessary to succeed in agriculture. Projects under the Initiative must be led by Indigenous communities or entrepreneurs who are focused on agriculture & food systems projects, or who are interested in building capacity to participate in the Canadian agriculture and agri-food sector.

Eligible activities can be categorized into two streams:

1. Community readiness and pre-development support activities; and

2. Support Indigenous food & agriculture systems projects

Details: The Initiative will provide up to \$500,000 per project per year, to a maximum of \$2.5M over 5 years.

Eligibility: Indigenous communities & entrepreneurs in the Canadian agriculture and agri-food sector.
