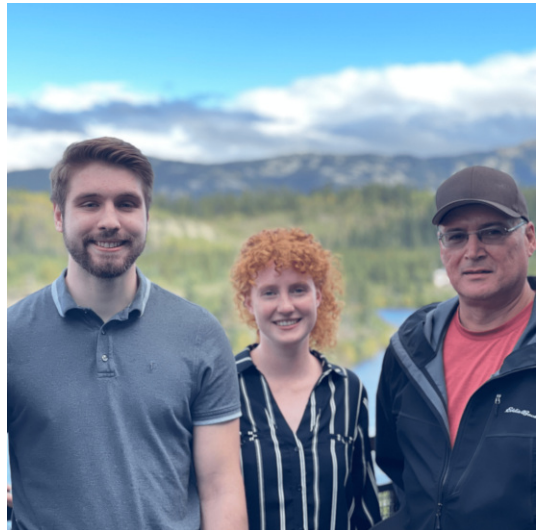
Strategies North has a Whitehorse Office!
